

OPEN PAYMENTS REPORTING

The Affordable Care Act created a U.S. national disclosure program Open Payments, a program that increases public awareness of financial relationships between the health care industry (for example, medical device manufacturers and pharmaceutical companies) and physicians or teaching hospitals. INSYS is required to report payments or transfers of value that it makes to United States licensed physicians or teaching hospitals. This data is collected by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and is publicly available and searchable online.

To use the CMS Open Payments Data search tool, visit <https://openpaymentsdata.cms.gov/search> to search for information regarding payments made by INSYS to physicians or teaching hospitals. All Open Payments data can be downloaded in detail, or search based on the Physician or Teaching Hospital receiving the payment, or the Company making the payment. REPORTABLE PAYMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF VALUE

Open Payments reports for INSYS include the following types of transfers of value it makes to Physicians and Teaching Hospitals (grouped by CMS-defined Natures of Payments):

- Charitable Contributions
- Compensation for services other than consulting, including serving as faculty or as a speaker at a venue other than a continuing education program
- Consulting Fees
- Education (e.g., medical text books, scientific journal articles)
- Food and Beverage (provided during business meetings)
- Research (on products to help advance patient care)
- Travel & Lodging (relating to consulting services and other business-related activities)
